Description	The archives of Westminster College, which was

	<p>founded in London in 1851, by the Wesleyan Methodist Church for the training of teachers. Initially women and men were trained until a separate women's college, (Southlands, Wimbledon) was founded in 1872.</p> <p>The college moved from its restricted and outdated buildings in Horseferry Road, Westminster, in 1959, to an extensive site on the western edge of Oxford. In 2000 it merged with Oxford Brookes University.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">***</p> <p>The records comprise a significant quantity of items from the 19<sup>th</sup> century (and property deeds relating to the Horseferry Road site, dating from 1687-1948) but the predominant holding is post-1920. It is known that some papers were destroyed by bombing in World War 2.</p> <p>The administrative records of the College comprise papers of the Trustees, Governing Body, Principals, Registrars, Bursars, Librarians and Archivists, Academic Board and other College Committee minutes.</p> <p>Sections of records relating to student life at the College include those of the Student Union, Athletic Committee, and Chapel. The majority of this material dates from the 1930s onwards. There are also records of alumni groups, principally the Westminster Club (and its regional branches) which was founded in 1886, and became the Westminster Society in 1991. Publications include <i>Westminster War Bulletin [WW1]</i>, <i>Westminster Club Bulletin</i>, <i>The Westminsterian</i> to the present day.</p> <p>Collections of artefacts include objects, photographs, and audio-visual items. There is a holding of books by, or about, staff and students (formerly known as the 'Ross Archive'). There are also some papers of the Wesleyan and (from 1932) Methodist Education Committees.</p> <p>There is also a collection of works of art, mainly portraits of Principals but including a 1948 view of the College by John Piper.</p>

Admin History	With a few exceptions, papers are derived from official records or staff of the College and College societies (including the Westminster Society) together with

	personal items from staff or students.
Custodial History	The College was generally efficient in maintaining its records, although disrupted by two major wars. The 1944 firebombing of the Chapel (where many papers were stored) resulted in significant losses. Listed in 1982-1984 by Brigid Allen, with additions made thereafter.
